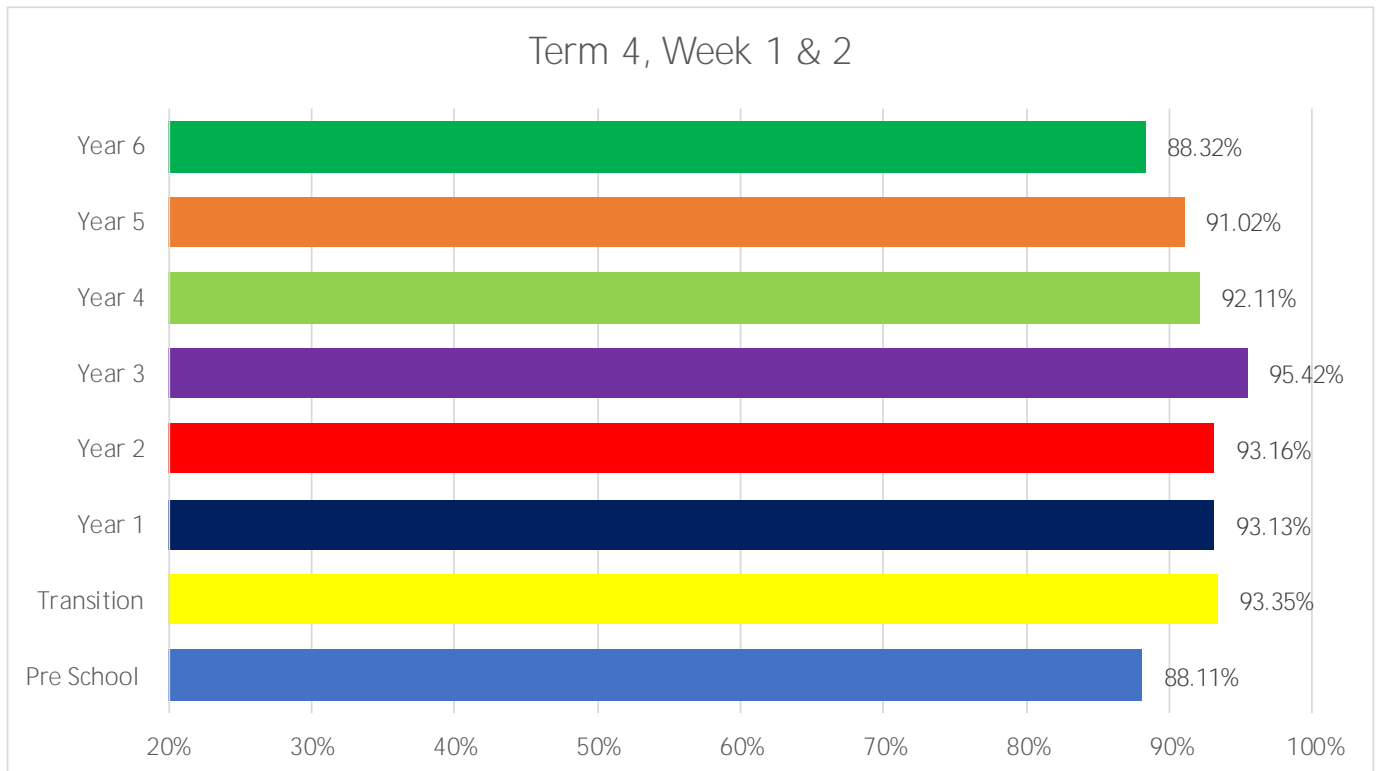

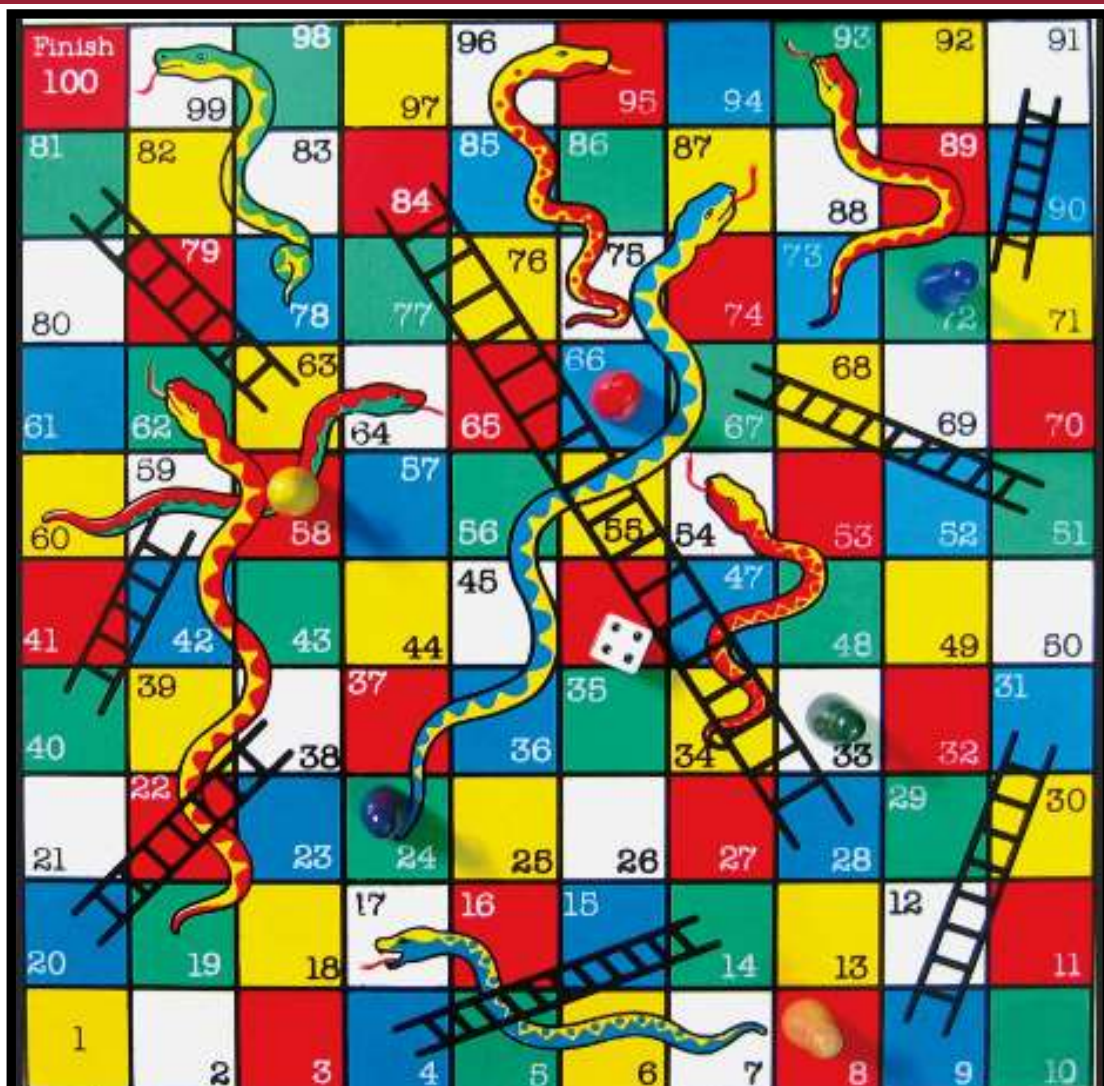


## Curriculum Spotlight: Mathematics

Students in Year 4 have been investigating and using properties of odd and even numbers when working in small groups. They have also been learning to solve problems involving money and using their knowledge of counting on and counting back strategies to assist them when calculating change to the nearest 5 cents. During Measurement and Geometry lessons, students have thoroughly enjoyed solving simple time problems and calculating the time required to travel between two locations.
