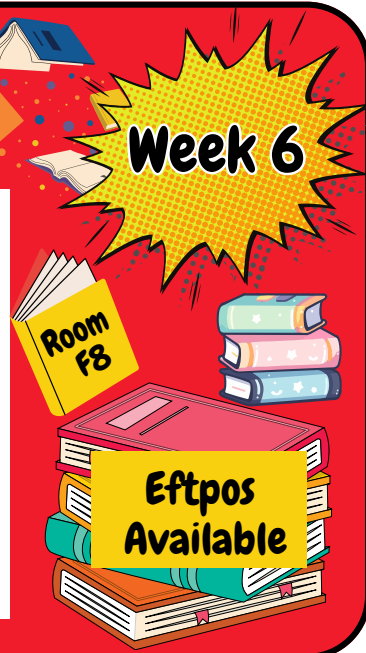


BAKEWELL BOOK FAIR

CLASS SPOTLIGHT

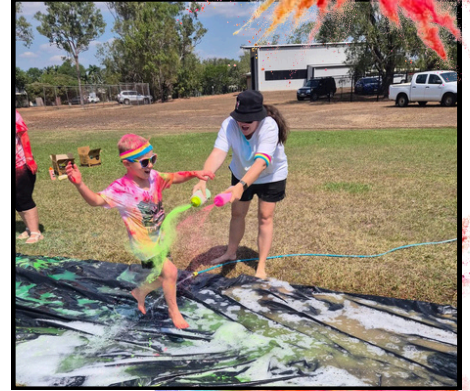
3 MCELLIN

Rules for riding your own e-scooter

If you own an e-scooter, you can only ride it on private property. You can't ride it on roads, footpaths or other public spaces.

Promoting Safer E-Scooter Use in the Northern Territory: A School-Community Collaboration
When schools share legislation and safety messages about e-scooter use with their wider community, it creates a ripple effect of awareness and responsibility. In the Northern Territory, where e-scooters are becoming increasingly popular among students, this collaboration helps reinforce the importance of safe riding habits, legal compliance, and mutual respect on shared paths.

Key benefits include:

- Improved Student Safety:** Reinforcing helmet use, speed limits, and safe routes reduces accidents and injuries.
- Legal Awareness:** Educating students and families on local e-scooter laws helps prevent fines and ensure responsible usage.
- Stronger School-Community Ties:** Joint efforts foster trust, communication, and a sense of shared responsibility.
- Positive Cultural Shift:** Promoting respectful e-scooter behaviour builds a safer and more considerate environment for everyone.

It's more than just passing information—it's planting a culture of safety and care that can grow beyond the school gates.

Why We Need to Be Careful with E-Scooters

E-scooters can be fun to ride, but they can also be a bit tricky. Here's why we need to use them safely:

- Bumps and Crashes:** If you go too fast or don't look where you're going, you might hit something and fall off. That can hurt!
- No Helmet? Big Problem!** Helmets protect your head like superhero shields. Without one, a bump could be serious.

It's okay to ride e-scooters on your own private property, but always ride smart, ride slow, and be safe—just like a superhero with wheels!
