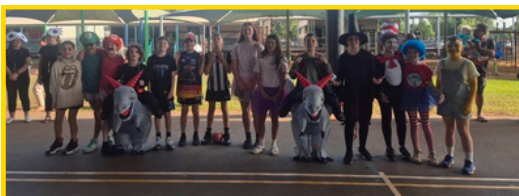
Illuminate Open Night
