Welcome back to Term Four! As we step into the final stretch of the school year, I'd like to take a moment to reflect on the importance of wearing our Bakewell uniforms with pride.

Our uniform is more than just clothing—it represents belonging, respect, and a shared commitment to our school values. With the warmer months ahead, student safety remains a top priority.

That's why we'll be reinforcing our long-standing **"No Hat, No Play"** policy, beginning next week. This approach ensures that all students are protected from the sun while enjoying outdoor play.

What's Changing?

Bakewell will begin a "Hat on head or sit out instead" approach.

Who?

All students are expected to bring a Bakewell school hat and wear it during play times.

How Will It Work?

- Teachers will line students up before recess and lunch, awarding a house point to each student who has their hat and takes it out to play.
- House points will be tallied every Thursday afternoon and celebrated at assembly.
- Students without a hat will spend time in a designated shaded space (Ts = Ablock veranda and 1-6 = demountable veranda, supervised by Ms Hall.
- If a student reaches four instances without a hat, a documented plan will be created. This may involve keeping a hat with a teacher or leadership member for collection at play times.

Let's work together to ensure every student feels proud in their uniform and protected in the sun. Thank you for your continued support in making Bakewell a safe, respectful, and vibrant learning community.



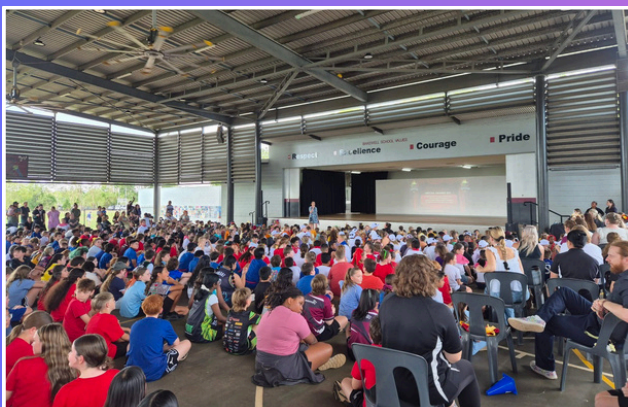
