Great news – less than 30 students daily have forgotten hats on their heads resulting in sitting out instead. There is another important safety concern I'd like to raise that affects every member of our school community—especially our children. It has come to our attention that some families

are choosing not to use the designated children's crossing when walking to and from their cars parked along Forrest Parade. While this may seem like a minor decision, it carries significant safety risks and sends a powerful message to our students.

The children's crossing is there to protect our most vulnerable road users. It offers a clearly marked, supervised space for safe crossing during busy drop-off and pick-up times. When adults bypass this crossing, it not only increases the risk of accidents but also undermines the safety routines we work hard to instil in our students.


Children learn by watching the adults around them. By consistently using the crossing, you're modelling responsible behaviour, reinforcing road safety education, and helping build a culture of care and awareness. Your actions set the tone for others—students, siblings, and fellow parents alike.

We ask for your support in making the children's crossing a non-negotiable part of your daily routine. It's a simple step that makes a big difference in keeping our school community safe. Thank you for your continued partnership and commitment to our students' wellbeing.
